

BUCKSKIN (NYLT) NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING

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June 10 through June 16, 2007

Buckskin (NYLT) is a 7-day outdoor experience for troop youth leaders designed to help support a Scoutmaster in his responsibility to train leaders. It is based on the National Youth Leadership Training program of the National Council, and presented by the Training Committee of the Buckskin Council, BSA.

Buckskin (NYLT) has 6 major objectives.

1. To give participants the confidence and knowledge to run the troop program.
2. To give participants a working knowledge of the eleven skills of leadership, and help them relate these skills to their troop responsibilities.
3. To give participants the opportunity to share ideas, and experiences with Scouts from other troops.
4. To create an atmosphere where Scouts will experience Scouting at it's best.
5. To enhance relationships between participant and Scoutmaster.
6. To have FUN.

Buckskin (NYLT) will be held at Camp Chief Logan, Chapmanville, WV the week of June 10 through June 16, 2007. (Sunday through Saturday). The cost will be \$125.00 if paid by May 1, 2007 and \$150.00 after May 1, 2007. A minimum of 4 patrols are to be formed. The age limit for (NYLT) is 12 years old and there is not limit on the number of patrol leaders a troop can send to the training. Fees for all names submitted must be paid within the guidelines listed above.

Buckskin (NYLT) is a training exercise in an outdoor laboratory. It's sole purpose is to develop leadership skills that Scouts will use in their home troop, and throughout their lives.
