Directions from Putnam and Kanawha County: Take I-64 East through Charleston. Take I-64, I-77 South at the split toward Beckley, West Virginia. Stay on I-64, I-77 toward Beckley until you come to the **Chelyan Exit**. Take the Chelyan Exit and at the bottom of the ramp, turn left and go across the Chelyan Bridge. Stay in right lane crossing the bridge and turn right on Route 60. Stay on Route 60 and follow the signs to Montgomery, West Virginia (about 10 miles). Cross the bridge at Montgomery and follow the signs to West Virginia University—Institute of Technology.

Directions from Beckley, Princeton, and Virginia areas. Take I-64, I-77 North toward Charleston, West Virginia. After you go through the last toll booth on I-64, I-77, take the next exit (**Chelyan Exit**). At the bottom of the ramp, turn right and go across the Chelyan Bridge. Stay in the right land crossing the bridge and turn right on Route 60. Stay on Route 60 and follow the signs to Montgomery, West Virginia (about 10 miles). Cross the bridge at Montgomery and follow the signs to West Virginia University—Institute of Technology.
